

SCHEDULE B
SMALL COMMERCIAL SERVICE
RATE CODE 040 AND 041

AVAILABILITY

Available to commercial and industrial, three-phase farm consumers, and all public buildings including schools and churches, for all uses subject to the established rules and regulations of TOUA.

Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements do not exceed 60 kW.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase, where available, 60 cycles, at TOUA's standard voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

Demand Charge -	First 10 kW	No charge
	Over 10 kW	\$6.75 per KW
Energy Charge -	First 50 kWh	\$0.3475 per kWh
	Next 950 kWh	\$0.1475 per kWh
	Over 1,000 kWh	\$0.1145 per kWh

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest of the following:

- (1) For all single-phase consumers requiring ten (10) KVA of transformer capacity or less, the minimum shall be \$15.00 per month.
- (2) For all three-phase consumers requiring ten (10) KVA of transformer capacity or less, the minimum shall be \$30.00 per month.
- (3) For all consumers requiring more than ten (10) KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum charge shall be increased at the rate of \$1.00 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof.
- (4) The minimum charge per month shall not be less than the monthly charge established in accordance with the line extension policy, or by special contract.
- (5) The consumer shall be entitled to use the number of kWh corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate in any one month; however, the above charges as established will be increased by the purchase power cost adjustment based on kWh used.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

Schedule B

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills for service are due and payable upon receipt. Bills with a balance of \$500.00 or more and thirty (30) days delinquent from "Due Date" shall be assessed a one and one-half percent (1 ½%) per month penalty charge. (See TOUA Rules and Regulations for Non-Payment Disconnects and Policies).

SEASONAL AND TEMPORARY SERVICE

Consumers requiring seasonal or temporary service will be evaluated individually and served under special contracts. Consumers requiring temporary service shall pay the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of salvageable materials. The Authority may require a deposit, in advance, for the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

TAX ADJUSTMENT

This schedule is subject to its proportionate part of any taxes or governmental impositions which are now or may in the future be assessed on the basis of plant facilities, gross revenues of TOUA or revenue from sales of electric energy or kilowatt-hours of electricity generated or purchased for sale and sold hereunder.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

If at any time after January 1, 2009, the rate under which the TOUA purchases electric energy at wholesale is modified, TOUA may make a corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder. This modification shall be based on kWh consumption as an additional charge to the above monthly rate and/or minimum charges.
