RATE CODE 045

AVAILABILITY:

Available to small commercial and industrial. Service under this rate schedule is subject to the Authority’s Rules and Regulations for Service.

Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements do not exceed 25 kW.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single Phase, where available, 60 cycles, TOUA’s standard voltages.

MONTHLY RATE:

Energy Charge-	First 50 kWh	\$0.3475 per kWh
	Next 950 kWh	\$0.1475 per kWh
	Over 1,000 kWh	\$0.1145 per kWh

MINIMUM CHARGE: \$11.50

NOTE: The word “Month or Monthly” as used in this schedule is defined to be the elapsed time between two (2) successive meter readings, approximately thirty (30) days apart.

DELIVERY POINT:

Unless otherwise specified in the service contract, the delivery point shall be the metering point when service is furnished at secondary voltage, or the point of attachment of the seller’s primary line to the consumer’s transformer structure if service is furnished at primary line voltage. All wiring, pole lines, and other equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the consumer.

SEASONAL AND TEMPORARY SERVICE:

Consumers requiring seasonal or temporary service will be evaluated individually and served in accordance with Authority’s Rules and Regulations for Service

BILLING AND PAYMENT:

All bills are due on or before the due date. The Due Date will be ten (10) days from the Billing Date. Bills not paid within twenty (20) days of the Billing Date will be considered delinquent. Customers that have a delinquent bill will be mailed a Late Payment Notice and assessed a three (3) percent penalty on the amount of the delinquent bill. Delinquent Bills are subject to disconnect for non-payment twenty-five (25) days after the Billing Date. If the Due Date falls on Saturday, Sunday or any holiday that TOUA’s

office is closed, the next business day will become the due date. If remittance is made by mail, the postmark date will become the date of payment.

Should service be discontinued for non-payment, re-connection shall be made during regular working hours after the bill is paid in full plus a \$25.00 re-connection fee.

SPECIAL CHARGES, FEES, AND TAXES:

There shall be added to the Customer's bill for service, an additional charge equal to the prorated share of any occupation, franchise, business, license, excise, privilege, or other similar charge or tax, now, or hereafter imposed by any taxing body or authority, whether by statute, ordinance, law, or otherwise, and whether presently due, or to hereafter become due.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

In addition to the above monthly rates a Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment "WPCA" will be added to the customer's monthly bill, based on the kWh consumed. The WPCA is calculated and expressed as a rate per kWh of sales to reflect the change in the cost of wholesale power that is above or below the cost of wholesale power used to determine the last cost of service rate adjustment (2009), referred to as the base period.
